## Summer Means Parties!

1. In all situations, your job is to **first, save yourself**: get to a safe place, preferably outside, & out front.

Think of it this way -- you can't lead someone to salvation if you don't have it yourself, so save yourself and then you are able to do something for your friend(s).

2. You have a great ally, who CAN save you all: **pray to GOD** while you get out of there.

3. You have a great tool: cell phones (mobiles).

- ❖ Turn the sounds **off** for when you **power up** the phone, so that in extreme emergency situations no one will know you are about to call for help. Hide the phone on you if you need to.
- ❖ All mobiles have emergency GPS technology to help the authorities find you, so please dial 911 and get outside, out front, so that help can find you. Let the authorities work out the final plan.
- ❖ And if help is slow in coming, you can run down the street to a neighbor's house, or to a shopping center, or to a public phone, which you can't do locked in a bathroom or in the backyard.
- ❖ Public phones are required to work when you dial 911 even without coins: dial 911 here if you don't have a working mobile phone.

## Internet Safety


**Personal info:** name, birthday, home address, phone numbers, family info., school info., gender, friend's info., **photos**, social security number, work info., passwords. Keep it to yourself. Online predators are hunting you with your info. Online thieves are hunting you and your family for IDs and shopping info. Facebook is not going to secure your info. if you post it for the world to collect.

**Screen names:** DON'T USE your personal info. in your screennames.

**House says, "Everyone lies":** people who love to harm are great liars; you will be fooled by one.

**Don't forward:** copy/paste text into a new message. **First** check with [www.snopes.com](http://www.snopes.com) for hoaxes. No company can track messages to collect funds/ for any needy nor deserving person. By passing on chain letters out of guilt you are clogging up someone's mailbox, possibly passing on viruses and your friend's email address to others they don't know, and often passing on false information which can scare someone into actions that aren't going to help them or even put them in danger. Plus, you'll feel stupid when you find out that the info was phony and you were dupped.

**So now you are at a party and you aren't sure if this situation is alright.**



## The question comes

### When do you cross the line and go against your friend's wishes?

1. "When death is on the line" -- *The Princess Bride*. Choose your friend's well-being over your friendship... pray that God will heal the friendship in time.
2. If death isn't on the line, you still need to pray and choose your friend's safety/well-being over your friendship: you may need to go it alone (but not without Jesus) for a while because you care more about your friend.

We all worry about our relationships, especially if they are new. That is why **when we get that "uncomfortable feeling**-knowing that something is wrong" **we wonder if we should say or do something**. The truth is you know what is right and what is wrong and you are not sure if it is ok to do what is right, RIGHT NOW, because you are worried about your relationship(s) with those involved. Listen to the Holy Spirit, follow His instructions. He will guide you into all right actions, even if at first you feel terrible about your choices.

This is true even when you are an adult... you will be concerned with your relationships, but you need to do what is right immediately and pray for God's guidance about working out the relationship afterward.

Rom. 8:31 **"What can we say in all this? If God is for us, who can be against us?"**

Heb. 13:5 **"I will never leave you nor forsake you..."**

2 Tim. 1:7 **"I have not given you a spirit of fear, but of strength, courage and a sound mind..."**

All drugs and alcohol cause you to lose the ability to make good choices, including those who have been taking them for a while... so assume that the danger you feel is real and act accordingly. Don't wait for proof of danger... it can come too late. **Save yourself, then you can save others. Stay in prayer and call for help.**
