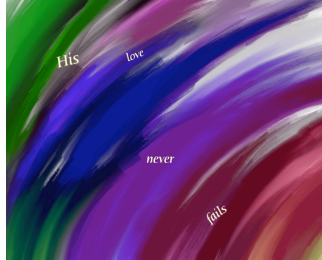

I have returned safely and am amazed at the blessings of God after leading the Artistic Outreach Weekend Workshop at a small Baptist church the 28th-30th of October. It never would have happened without your help.

The New Team!

We formed a new outreach team that will use drama to reach the lost & the hurting. Several young people and the "**Women of Empowerment**" (the hosts) learned the principles of artistic outreach, as well as how to be a ministry-minded drama outreach team. They also learned three new skits to help them with their next local community outreach event.

The short skit script, "**The Colors of Salvation**" was written for this team knowing that they would need an extremely flexible script that considered the few participants with little experience available. **They made it their own** by choosing to use a narrator (their Director, Mrs. Deborah London). Children, as young as seven years old, used the seven colored cloths as the only props to show the message of salvation.

They beautifully threw themselves into the multimedia presentations and rehearsals and presented the Good News through drama to their own congregation, **Long Branch First Baptist**, Rev. Larry Dixon, Pastor, during the Sunday morning worship service. The team's willingness to work and **the warmth and hospitality of the entire congregation greatly encouraged me**. The generous donation Long Branch gave to this ministry will now allow another assembly to host the workshop in its community regardless of the size of its budget.

The trip was difficult, but worthwhile. Please continue praying for this ministry.
